

Disty DECT Base Duo - 2 Line DECT

The disty base duo is a DECT/GAP base station for universal use with up to 8 GAP handsets or the disty box³⁰⁰ or disty box⁵⁰⁰⁰. It is the ideal solution for operating two analogue lines on a low-cost DECT system.

The distybase duo can be employed in a variety of ways in the home and office, both directly on the public phone network and as a small-scale DECT solution on PABXs.

The distybase duo exant version, connected to an external aerial, and can bridge distances of up to 9 km when used in combination with the disty $\rm box^{5000}$.
